

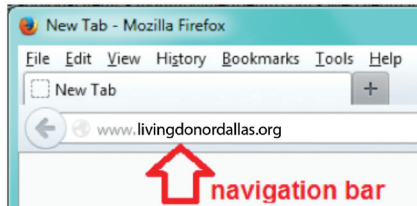
Are You Considering KIDNEY DONATION?

The first step is for you to complete our confidential online health history questionnaire. Please type the following into your browser:

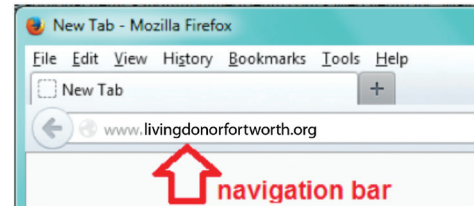
