We ask that you schedule your child's next wellness exam at the end of the last wellness exam. If you are unable to do so, we suggest calling and scheduling at least 2-4 months before your child is due for their next exam to ensure your child is seen on schedule.

| 1 shot | 1 st week: Follow up from hospital after discharged (1 st newborn screening & Hepatitis B #1 given at hospital) |

| 1 shot | 1 month: Checkup, Hep B |
| 2 shots 1 oral | 2 months: Checkup, (DTap, Hib, Polio), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus |
| 2 shots 1 oral | 4 months: Checkup, (DTap, Hib, Polio), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus |
| 3 shots 1 oral | 6 months: Checkup, (DTap, Hib, Polio), Pneumococcal, Rotavirus, Hep B |
| *1 shot | 9 months: Checkup (Hep B dose if 3 rd not given at 6 months) |
| 3 shots | 12 months: (<u>must</u> be after 1 st birthday) Checkup, MMR, Varicella, Hepatitis A #1 (Iron & lead labs) |
| 3 shots | 15 months: Checkup, DTap, HIB, Pneumococcal |
| 1 shot | 18 months: Checkup, Hep A #2 |
| *1 shot | 2 years: Checkup (Hep A dose if 2 nd not given at 18 months) |
| | 3 years: Checkup |
| 2 shots | 4 years: (must be after 4 th birthday) Checkup, (MMR and Varicella), (DTap and Polio) |
| | 5-10 years: Checkup |
| 2 shots 1 optional | 11 years: Checkup, TDap, Meningococcal group A, start HPV series* optional (labs drawn at provider's discretion) |
| | 12-15 years: Checkup only |
| 1 shot 1 optional | 16 years: Meningococcal group A, Meningococcal group B* optional |

Hib: haemophilus influenza B MMR: measles, mumps, rubella
