Baylor University Medical Center, part of Baylor Scott & White Health, serves as a regional destination for women faced with high-risk pregnancies and critically ill newborns. Baylor Dallas' Maternal and Neonatal Transport Teams are available 24/7 and consist of specialized registered nurses and respiratory therapists with advanced training in maternal and neonatal intensive care.

Maternal Transport and High Risk Maternal Medicine Services

Baylor Dallas offers a 30-bed dedicated antepartum unit and a high-risk labor and delivery unit, both equipped with advanced technology and an entire team focused on the long-term care of both mom and fetus. Baylor Dallas' advanced skilled labor and delivery registered nurse (RN) transport team provides services for:

- High-risk pregnancies, including fetal anomalies
- Pregnant women with critical medical conditions
- Premature labor

Neonatal ICU Transport

Baylor Dallas has a dedicated Neonatal Transport Team that has an 83-bed neonatal intensive care unit (NICU). Each transport team is staffed by advanced skilled RNs and respiratory therapists with expertise in neonatal care. Services include:

- Attendance at high-risk deliveries for patients who can't be transported so that mom/baby can be immediately stabilized and transported, if necessary
- Transfer of critically ill infants, including stabilization and full neonatal management: bubble CPAP, intubation and ventilator therapy, surfactant administration, umbilical line placement, needle thoracotomy, x-ray interpretation and full code situations
- Transport and initiation of total body cooling for infants who have suffered a hypoxic ischemic event and qualify for therapy

The Maternal and Neonatal transport teams will use the most appropriate means of transport, via helicopter, ground ambulance or plane, to provide a safe trip for your patient. Referring physicians are updated on their patients' conditions weekly by our transport coordinator.

Education

Baylor Dallas is committed to education and offers several classes for Labor and Delivery and New Family Center staff. These include STABLE, neonatal resuscitation, fetal monitoring classes and simulation opportunities.
