



Baylor Scott & White Medical Center – McKinney Fact Sheet

Baylor Scott & White Medical Center – McKinney is a 143-bed facility located at the northwest corner of University Drive (Highway 380) and Lake Forest Drive in McKinney, Texas. The 469,000 square-foot, full-service medical center opened in July 2012 and is dedicated to serving the residents of McKinney and surrounding communities.

Baylor Scott & White – McKinney has more than 1,000 medical staff members, representing multiple medical specialties and sub-specialties. As part of the medical center's long-term plans, the hospital structure can add more floors, increasing the number of beds to 400. The Emergency Department has already expanded, doubling the existing space, and the fifth floor of the hospital also has been built out to accommodate a dedicated orthopedics unit that is complete with a rehabilitation gym. A second physician office building was recently added to the campus.

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Overview of Services

Cancer Care

From surgery to counseling to rehabilitation, we provide services that cover the entire continuum of care for cancer patients and their families. A breast imaging center on our campus also includes digital mammography.

The hospital is accredited by the Commission on Cancer of the American College of Surgeons.

Digestive Disease

We have created a comfortable and thoughtful diagnostic facility for procedures, such as colonoscopy or endoscopic ultrasound, where care and privacy are of the utmost importance.

Emergency Department

When an emergency happens, our doors are always open. Emergency care is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Since opening, the Emergency Department has expanded, doubling the space to increase capacity. We are designated by the Texas Department of State Health Services as an Advanced Level III Trauma Facility.

Heart and Vascular Services

We offer everything from prevention and assessment to cardiac interventional therapies and vascular surgery. We are accredited by the Society of Cardiovascular Patient Care in Chest Pain.

Imaging Services

For patients needing a computed tomography (CT) scan or another imaging exam, we have a fully equipped diagnostic center that can handle advanced imaging needs in a timely, efficient manner. Additionally, the Women's Imaging Center has been designated a Breast Imaging Center of

Excellence by the American College of Radiology. The Women's Imaging Center offers digital mammography, stereotaxis, breast ultrasound and more.

Intensive Care

In addition to our 16 intensive care private suites, we utilize in-house, board-certified intensivists who are specially trained in treating patients in the Intensive Care Unit (ICU).

Internal Medicine - Hospitalists

Specially trained internal medicine physicians on the medical staff, called hospitalists, care for our patients. Hospitalists work alongside primary care physicians and specialists to address the healthcare needs of our patients. In addition to hospitalists, our medical staff includes numerous internal medicine physicians practicing a variety of specialties.

Neurology Services

When faced with a neurological issue, patients want to know they are in good hands. We offer one-stop access to physicians on the medical staff and a care team with the expertise in diagnosing and managing conditions such as stroke, epilepsy, Parkinson's disease, Alzheimer's disease and other conditions. The hospital is designated by The Joint Commission as a Primary Stroke Center.

Orthopedics

From comprehensive joint care to sports medicine to orthopedic trauma, we combine personalized care with expertise to offer a full range of orthopedic care services, including anterior hip replacement. We also offer a dedicated orthopedics unit complete with a rehabilitation gym.

Surgical Services

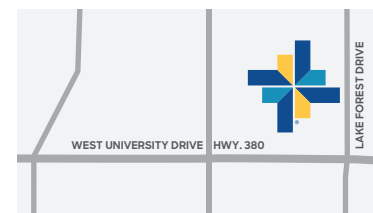
