Here are a few ways your HSA Plan can help you get—and stay—healthy.



**Expanded network:** Visit providers in the Tier 1, 2 and 3 networks. Remember, providers in the Tier 1 BSWQA Network are always the best value.



No-cost preventive care: Staying on top of your health is good for your body and your wallet! In-network preventive visits are free with this plan, and Tier 1 eVisits are covered at 100% after the deductible has been met.



Contribute tax-free dollars to an HSA for healthcare expenses: Use your funds to pay for any eligible medical, dental and vision expenses. They never expire so you can save them for future expenses too.



Healthcare in the palm of your hand: Use the MyBSWHealth app to manage your healthcare needs, review your medical record, make appointments and connect with providers through eVisits or video visits. See page 6 for more information.



## Healthcare in the palm of your hand

With eVisits and video visits, you can access care any day of the week without leaving your home or office.

### Virtual care is only available in Texas. Use eVisits/video visits for common conditions such as:

- Respiratory infections, allergies and COVID-19
- Medication to prevent illness after flu exposure
- Fye, ear and mouth pain
- Skin and nail concerns
- Head lice and tick bites

- Flu prevention and travel medication
- Sprains and strains\*
- Low back pain\*
- Minor headache\*

#### Ready to get started?

#### **eVisits**

- ▼ Log in to your MyBSWHealth account\*
- Click eVisit under the Get Care tiles > Schedule Now option
- Fill out a brief questionnaire about your symptoms and click Send
- A provider will diagnose your symptoms and send you a message within the hour
- You will receive a notification via text/email when your eVisit is ready for your review
- ▼ Log back in to MyBSWHealth, and in the eVisit section, select Review Results
- If applicable, you will select your desired pharmacy to send your prescription(s)
- Behavioral health eVisits are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and a BSW provider will usually respond to your request within two hours

#### Video visit

- Log in to the MyBSWHealth app
- Click Video Visits under the Get Care tile > Schedule Now option
- Choose the type of Video Visit you prefer. Options include:
  - Local Doctors: With a new provider in your area; hours and availability vary by provider
  - On-Call: With an on-call provider when you need care fast
- At your scheduled appointment time, launch the video chat from your home screen in the MyBSWHealth app or website browser
- If applicable, a prescription will be sent to the pharmacy of your choice



### BSW pharmacies save you time and money!

- Receive a 20% discount on over-thecounter medications with your badge.
- Choose from 30+ BSW pharmacies, a dedicated specialty pharmacy, 24/7 kiosks or our nationwide contracted network.
- Take a maintenance medication? The BSW Pharmacy (retail or mail order) is the only way to fill a 90-day supply of a medication at a reduced cost.
- Use the MyBSWHealth app to refill, transfer between locations and manage prescriptions. This feature is also available on the web at MyBSWHealth.com.

- Fertility drugs are covered at 20% with a maximum \$400 copay and a \$7,500 lifetime maximum pharmacy benefit.
- Drugs not listed on the formulary may require prior authorization. If authorized, you'll pay the applicable non-preferred or specialty copay.
- Member Choice program requires generic medication fills when available; if a brand name medication is requested (when a generic is available), you'll pay the non-preferred member cost share plus the difference in cost between the brand name and generic equivalent drug.
- \* Only BSW pharmacies can fill a 90-day supply of a medication. The max day supply through a contracted pharmacy is 30 days. Specialty drugs are only available at BSW pharmacies.
- † Pharmacy costs between BSW pharmacies and contracted pharmacies cross apply between Tier 1 and Tier 2 and are subject to the Tier 1 deductible and out-of-pocket maximum.
- ++ Specialty is limited to 30 days at BSW pharmacies.

## **BSW Maternity Care Management**

Support for every step of motherhood

From feeling your baby's first kicks to seeing your baby's first steps, travel the journey of motherhood with experts by your side. The BSW Maternity Care Management program is here to give you information, resources and support for every step of motherhood.

### The program is free for all expecting moms (employees and dependents) enrolled in a BSW medical plan. Enrollees receive:

- Access to a nurse 24 hours a day, seven days a week
- Farly enrollment in case management
- Extra guidance for high-risk pregnancies
- Coordinated efforts to promote full-term birth
- Extra assistance for women who previously delivered pre-term

- In-home support for high-risk conditions such as diabetes, hypertension and severe nausea
- Screening for early identification of perinatal depression

#### **Bundled maternity copay** Understanding maternity costs

As an enrollee in the HSA for 2023, maternity costs would be calculated according to the plan:
Once your deductible is met, you pay 10% for Tier 1 services, 50% for Tier 2 and 80% for Tier 3.

Note: Your baby would need to be added to your BSW plan within 30 days of birth for well-baby expenses to be covered.

## **Healthy Pregnancy Digital Care Journey**

All medical plan participants can take part in a free program through MyBSWHealth for expecting moms which includes information, resources and support for every step of pregnancy, including education on fetal growth and development, self-care, breastfeeding and planning for baby's care after birth.

If you are seeing a BSW provider with Epic access, ask him/her to initiate Healthy Pregnancy Digital Care Journey for you. When your journey is live, enable Care Coach messages from your app settings to begin.

**Text4baby:** If you are seeing a non-BSW provider, you can still get support with the Text4baby app or **Text4baby.org** site.



## Pro tip: Questions to ask your provider

When it comes to your care, curiosity always comes in handy. Here are some helpful questions to ask when you're with your provider:

#### General

- When should I expect to feel better?
- What steps can I take to feel better?
- What do I need to do between now and my next visit?
- What are my options for after-hours care?

#### **Treatment**

- What are my treatment options?
- Will my insurance cover this treatment and is prior authorization required?
- What do I need to know about this treatment?

#### Medication

- Is this prescription covered by my plan?
- Is this generic?
- Do you have a sample I could try?
- Do I still need these medications?

## Pro tip: Use your Health Savings Account and limited-purpose FSA

**If you enrolled in an HSA**, the amount you chose during enrollment is credited to your account each pay period during your plan year. You can use the funds as they are available to pay for any eligible medical, dental and vision expenses. Funds never expire, so you can save them for future expenses too.

You can modify your contribution amount at any time during the year by submitting a ticket with PeoplePlace. The IRS places limits on how much you can set aside each year. Save up to \$3,850 if you're single and up to \$7,750 if you have a family.

**If you enrolled in a limited-purpose FSA**, use your fully loaded debit card from Optum Bank to pay for eligible dental and vision expenses not paid for under the plan, including deductibles, copays and coinsurance. Once your medical plan deductible has been met, you can use this FSA for medical and Rx expenses too.

As a reminder, use-it-or-lose-it applies. You have until March 15, 2024, to incur eligible expenses.



Before you pay a medical bill, compare it to your Baylor Scott & White Health Plan (BSWHP) Explanation of Benefits (EOB) statement found on the **Member Portal**. You'll find the provider's cost, the network discount and how much you might owe the provider.

If your medical bill does not match the member responsibility included on the EOB, contact your provider to confirm the details.

#### Here's what to do:

- 1. Log in to the Member Portal at BSWHealthPlan.com/BSWH
- 2. Click on Insurance & Bill Pay > Baylor Scott & White Health Plan > Claims from the menu bar on the left side of your screen
- 3. From the Claims page, search for the date of your visit
- **4.** Click on "Processed" from the Status column, then Explanation of Benefits (EOB)
  - The EOB tells you the billed amount, plan discount, plan paid, amount not covered and what you may owe for the visit
  - If the claim is "In Process" status, you will be able to view your EOB once the processing of the claim is complete
  - If there is not an EOB available for the date of your visit, contact your provider to confirm the claim has been submitted to BSWHP
- 5. If the amount you owe is being applied to your copay, deductible or coinsurance for services provided that were not paid at the time of the service, your provider is likely to bill you for that amount
- **6.** If your provider is part of the network and is billing you for more than the allowed amount, contact BSWHP Customer Advocacy at **844.843.3229** for assistance


